Belišće Paper Mill was founded in 1960, situated in east part of Croatia on river Drava bank. The Mill is leading paper producer in Croatia with excellent highway connections to Europe and Rijeka, the largest port in Croatian part of Adriatic, focusing on regional, but also serving other markets.

Milestones

- 1884 Site founded as a sawmill
- 1960 PM1 and steam boiler K1 startup start of paper production in Belišće
- **1971** Large reconstruction and modernisation of technology including a start of steam boiler K2
- **1975** Startup of PM2
- 1984 Startup of PM3
- **1992** Transformation and privatisation of Belišće d.d.
- **1996** Introduction of ISO 9002
- 1999 Reconstruction and modernisation of PM2 and PM3
- 2003 Introduction of ISO 9001
- **2006** Introduction of ISO 14001
- **2007** New PM2 winder
- 2008 Duropack AG becomes 24% shareholder. Reconstruction of steam and condensate system on PM2 and PM3
- 2012 Duropack GmbH becomes 100% shareholder of Belišće. Press section rebuild. SC Fluting production discontinued
- 2013 New dry section drives, new steam boilers K5 and K6
- 2014 PM3 shutdown
- 2015 Acquisition by DS Smith
- 2016 Restart of PM3
